East Victoria Park Primary School has recently employed the services of Professor Christopher Brook to guide the development of a whole school approach to meeting the needs of students identified as above developmental level (also known as *gifted learners*).

As part of the school program, Professor Brook invites interested parents and carers to a one-hour workshop in which he will discuss the special needs of those students who come to school above developmental expectations. He will outline student characteristics, how these students might be identified, the special needs of identified students, strategies to support the learning of these students (at home and school) and why he encourages teachers and parents to avoid the term *Gifted Learners*.

This is a free interactive session where parents are welcome to contribute and share their experience. For optimal workshop conditions we ask you to make arrangements for your children's care as it is not appropriate for them to attend.
