Dear Parents/Carers

The East Victoria Park Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of contributions and charges for **2026** in accordance with the School Education Regulations 2000 as part of the School Education Act 1999. The schedule provides you with information about anticipated costs that may occur throughout the coming school year.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS - \$60 per student

Financial support by parents/caregivers has always played a significant role in providing resources that extend the school's capacity to add value to the learning experiences of students. The continuing partnership between our school and parents/caregivers is vital to ensuring that all students receive a level of education sufficient to carry them forward in today's society.

While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our learning programs are maximised when all families contribute.

Funds raised through contributions allow us to enhance the learning environment at East Victoria Park Primary School through purchasing resources and running programmes to benefit all students. Payments can be made directly to the school or through Campion Education when purchasing from the Personal Items List.

The annual school voluntary contribution is \$60 per child. This is the amount set in the *School Education*.

OTHER VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS - \$20 per student

The Technology Levy: Monies raised assist the school to provide high quality iPads and laptops for students to access. The school chooses to provide access to school devices rather than a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program, as required by some schools.

CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS

During the year, students will engage in a variety of activities associated with educational programs for which charges will be incurred.

Please note that these are anticipated activities and charges and not a guarantee that they will occur. A written note detailing the activity and charges will be issued at the time the activity is scheduled and students who wish to participate must have paid prior to the event taking place.

PERSONAL ITEMS (REQUIREMENTS)

All students will receive a Campion Education Personal Requirements List for 2026. Items may be purchased from Campion or any stationery retailer you choose.

These are items that students are expected to always have and may need to be replenished from time to time.

Please note:

- Many items can be reused year after year.
- Please ensure all items are clearly marked so that equipment is easy to return to your child if found.

P&C CONTRIBUTION - \$50.00 per family

Each year the P & C requests a voluntary contribution from families which helps support P & C managed activities, the second-hand uniform shop, and other amenities at the school. Payments can be made directly to the school or via the Campion Education Personal Requirements List.
